These items represent what was in the Alice Sharp safe deposit box at Harris (now defunct and taking over. Most of these items are accounted for in the safety deposit box and will be split among Kelly and Steve.

Motably missing from the Harris bank list are:

Item 77: Gold bars 100 Grams, Credit Suisse 1 Grams, Degussa

100 gram bar = 3.215 ounces. 3.215 x \$1,322 - **\$4252.16** 1 gram bar = **\$42.56** 

Side note: The Harris Bank statement is only for the contents of the safety deposit box left by Alice Sharp. We are currently pursuing evidence/documentation to verify other rare metals and coins passed on to Alice by her Aunt believed to be in a floor safe of Bedroom 2's closet. Unfortunately, one month later when excavation of the property occurred, the safe was found, unlocked, and full of muddy water.
