This letter is to advise you that State Farm General Insurance Company is pursuing a subrogation claim against Southern California Edison (SCE) in the above-referenced matter. We believe SCE may be legally responsible for the damage to your property arising out of the January 2018 Southern California Montecito Debris Flow. State Farm has retained the law firm of Grotefeld Hoffmann to assist in the subrogation aspects of this claim.

We will seek to recover from SCE, through litigation, the amount of money that was paid to resolve your claim under your policy of insurance with State Farm.

Consequently, you may wish to contact any potentially responsible party(s) or their insurance company to present your claim for such losses.

Please keep in mind that your policy gives us the right to pursue recovery of our payments from any party responsible for the loss. Please call us to discuss any questions or concerns.

Note that the above information does not change the State Farm claims process, and your State Farm claim handler has not changed. You should continue to contact your assigned State Farm claim handler on your claim to discuss your damages and repairs. The State Farm employees listed at the bottom of this letter are coordinating our recovery efforts with State Farm's attorneys.
